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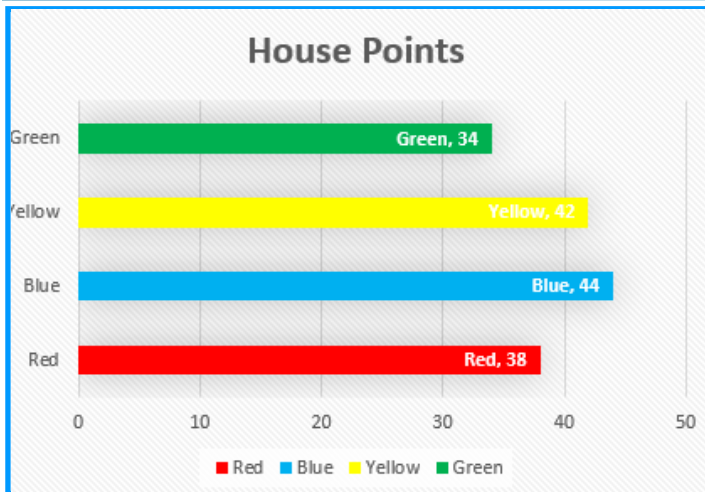

Year 2 Blue Anegan (P) trying hard to solve multiplication & division, Ethan (P) working hard to edit & improve recount of trip

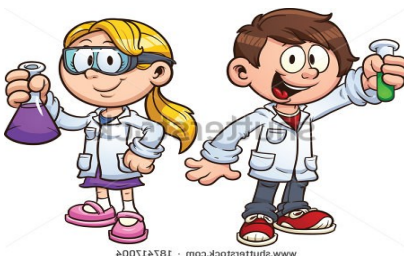
Year 3 Red Franky-Joe (Su) supporting others with their mammoth work, Tulisa (Su) supporting others with their mammoth work
