The non-school uniform for St George's Day raised a fantastic £261.50.

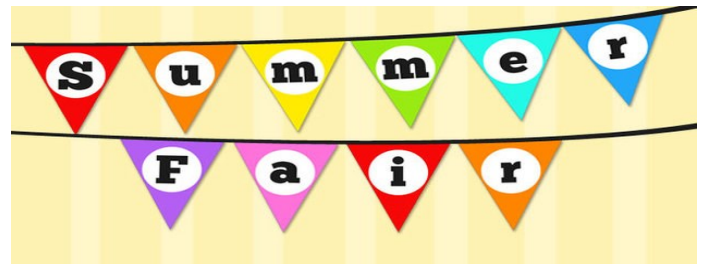
Thank you to all parents/carers for their support with this event.
