English

Then, the children will be writing a persuasive letter to Mr Heappey to request that Walter Tull (World War I officer) is awarded The Military Cross.

Maths

RE Day

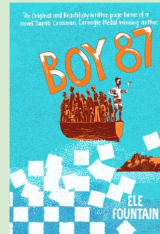
This term, our big question is "What can be done to reduce racism? Can religion help?".
