EYFS Learning Flyer - Term 2

This Learning Flyer shows what your child will be learning this term.

Phonics - Literacy

Children in Reception will continue to practice their single sounds, and focus on blending the sounds that they hear into words. This key skill will support them with their independent reading. We will also work on our writing and formation of the letters in our phonics books. In Nursery, we will be considering sounds that different vehicles make and begin assigning some words to their initial single sounds.

Maths

In Reception, we will be delving deeper into numbers to five this term, exploring composition, representation, and simple arithmetic like 'one more' and 'one less.' We'll also continue our learning with 2D shapes, defining them by their properties, such as a triangle having three sides. To reinforce children's skills in counting and subitizing, we will pose questions related to transportation during free-flow. For example; 'How many cars can you count?'"

In Nursery we will be exploring numbers 1 - 5 beginning with numbers 1, 2, 3, singing it in songs and how to represent it.

Understanding the World

This term, we'll explore transport, comparing past, present, and future modes of travel. We'll discuss differences between local and global transportation, and emphasize road safety. We'll also reflect on our own daily journeys to school. In light of Remembrance Day, we'll discuss how we remember those who fought for our freedom. **How can you help?**

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

As we learn about transport we'll ask the children to reflect on their own routines and how they get to school each day. We'll continue learning about the zones of regulation and try to identify our own emotions.

Communication and Language

Reception and Nursery will be encouraged to talk about transport, they can role play with vehicles and act out parts of their day. They'll be encouraged to listen to questions and answer them in full sentences.

How can you help?

Ask your child to tell you what they learnt about transport today. Encourage them to speak in full sentences.

Expressive Arts and Design

In Art we'll be trying out different materials when we make things, from clay to make Diwali lights to cardboard boxes to make our own types of transport. The children will be encouraged to talk through their creative process.

For RE this term we will be thinking about 'Which people are special and why?' to us and within Christianity and Catholicism.

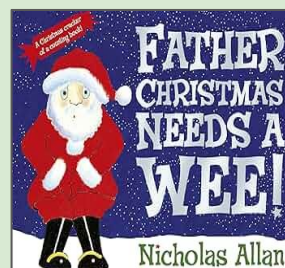
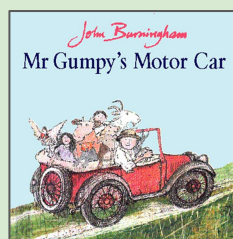
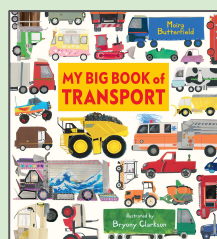
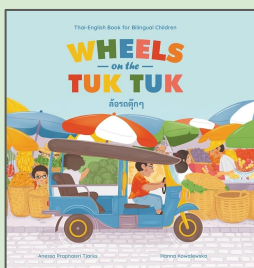
Physical Development
