Phonics - Literacy

We'll be diving into captivating animal stories, poems, and songs.As we approach the end of the year we're also encouraging children to write sentences about animals independently, and share what they've read from non-fiction books. **How can you help?** <u>Write a</u> <u>sentence about the animals you</u> <u>can see in the video!</u>

<u>Understanding the World</u> We will look at the similarities and differences between animals and their habits. We will also explore the natural world around us and make observations. **How can you help?** Let's go to the woods <u>Game: Where do these animals</u> live?

Walk and Talk - National

<u>Maths</u>

Reception's next block of learning is to visualise, build and map. We will be looking at repeating patterns and creating our own. We will look at visualising and describing positions. We will explore maps and create our own maps of familiar places and from stories.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will create animal artwork based on different parts of the life cycle and will design different animal habitats. We will make props to act out stories such as Monkey Puzzle and The Very Hungry Caterpillar. We will sing and dance to animal songs such as 'Down in the Jungle' and '5 Little Monkeys'. Can you learn the words to this animal song?

<u>Home Learning</u> Try to read and watch phonics videos and get your reading record signed to have your read counted! Please talk to your child about what they would do if they had a worry at home and school.

<u>RE Day - What is special about our</u> world?

This term we will be thinking about what is special about our world, looking at non-religious views and comparing beliefs we learnt about.

Physical Development

Reception will continue to take their P.E lessons with Coach Robbie, but in the classroom we'll be focusing on improving our gross motor skills through mimicking animal movements; stomping like elephants, slithering like snakes, or waddling like penguins! These activities help develop coordination, balance, and control over large muscle movements, also building stamina and overall fitness. **How can you help? Animal dance!**
