English

Maths

In Maths, we will begin our unit of fractions. We will look at comparing and ordering fractions as well as how to add and subtract fractions that have different denominators. Once we have completed this, we will look at how to multiply and divide fractions. We will continue with our pure problem-solving lessons

In Science this term, we will be researching evolution and inheritance, exploring variation and how living things adapt and evolve to survive.

This term, our topic will be The Suffragettes. Throughout this, we will be looking about British Democracy in the 19th Century, the Anti-Suffrage Campaign and the National Union of Women's Suffrage Society. As well as this, we will conduct a study on Emmeline Pankhurst.

Design Technology

Throughout the term, pupils will be employing different skills as part of our enterprise topic. This includes: design, clay moulding, sewing, baking and advertisement.

Physical Education

With our Team Theme coach, the children will be learning dance and creating various movements and patterns. In our second session, we will be learning how to play football!

Computing

We will be exploring the history of computers and their impact on the modern world. We will also be creating media and editing sound software!

Art

This term year 6 will be studying advanced colour theory combinations. They will use a variety of painting skills and various media to create some fantastic, vibrant artwork inspired by the Pop Art movement and the abstract artist Bulsby Duncan.

Geography

This terms Geography learning will focus on British Geographical Issues. By the end of the unit, the children will be able to explain some of the environmental challenges that we face in Britain.
