

## Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) - Year 5

Dear Parents/carers,

During Term 6, we will be teaching children about health and sex education as part of our PSHE programme of study - *Relationships and Sex Education (RSE)*. The following table shows what your child will be learning about next term as part of their PSHE lessons.

|          | Content Covered  |

| Lesson 1 | Self and Body Image : I am aware of my own self-image and how my body image fits into that.  |
| Lesson 2 | <b>Puberty for Girls</b> : I can explain how a girl's body changes during puberty and understand the importance of looking after yourself physically and emotionally.                              |
| Lesson 3 | Puberty for Boys: I can describe how boys' and girls' bodies change during puberty.  |
| Lesson 4 | <b>Conception:</b> I understand that sexual intercourse can lead to conception and that is how babies are usually made. I also understand that sometimes people need IVF to help them have a baby. |
| Lesson 5 | <b>Looking Ahead 1</b> : I can identify what I am looking forward to about becoming a teenager and understand this brings growing responsibilities (age of consent).                               |
| Lesson 6 | Looking Ahead 2: I can identify what I am looking forward to when I move to a new class.   |
